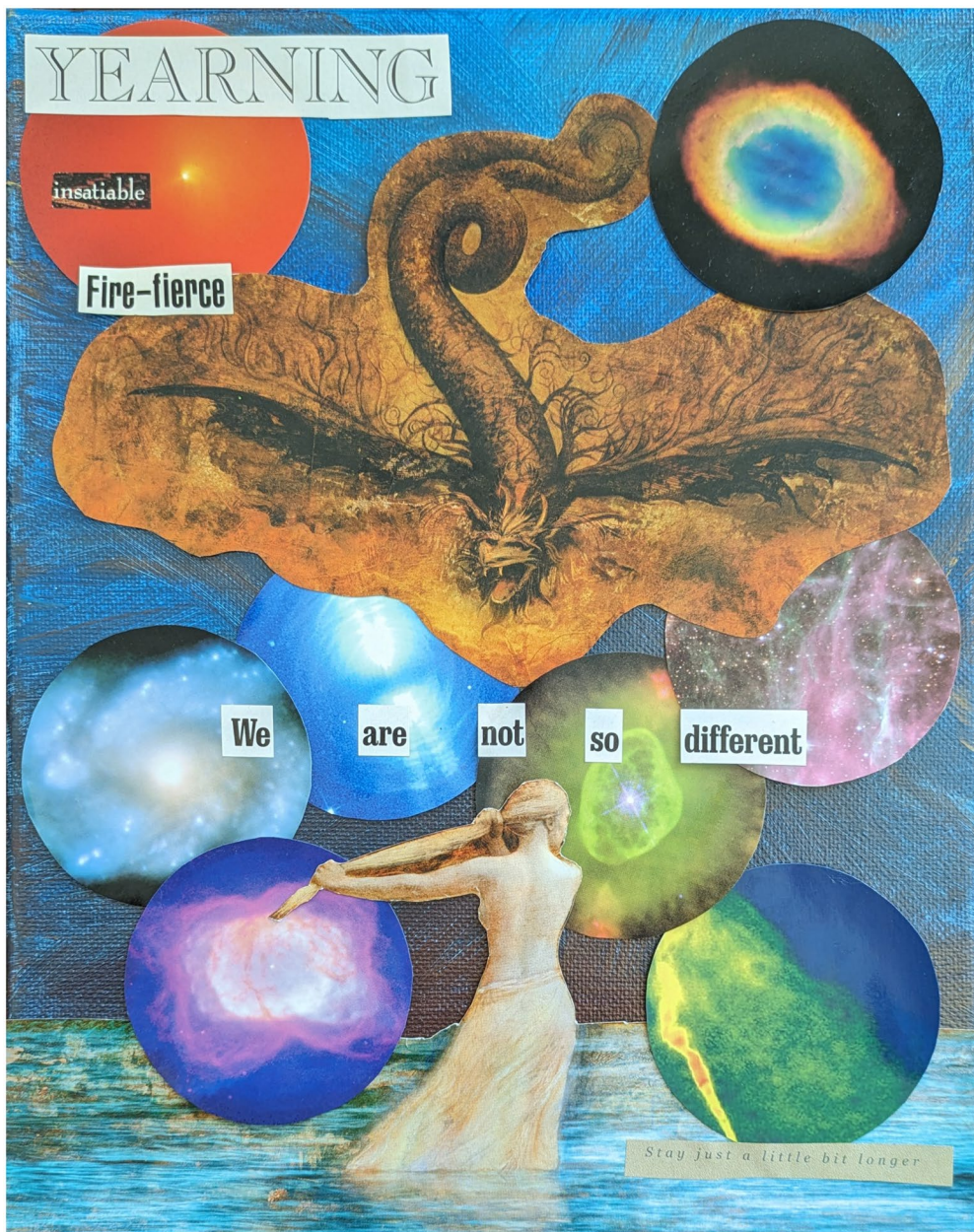

### Artist's note

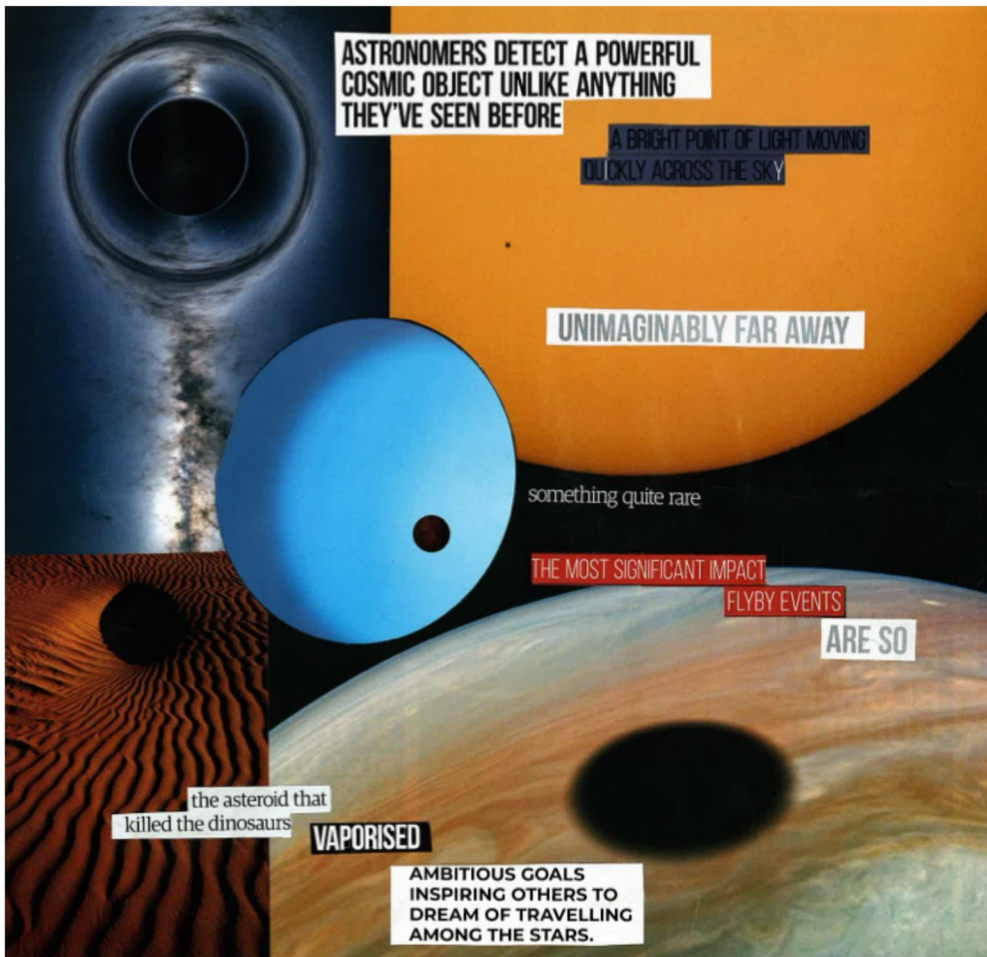

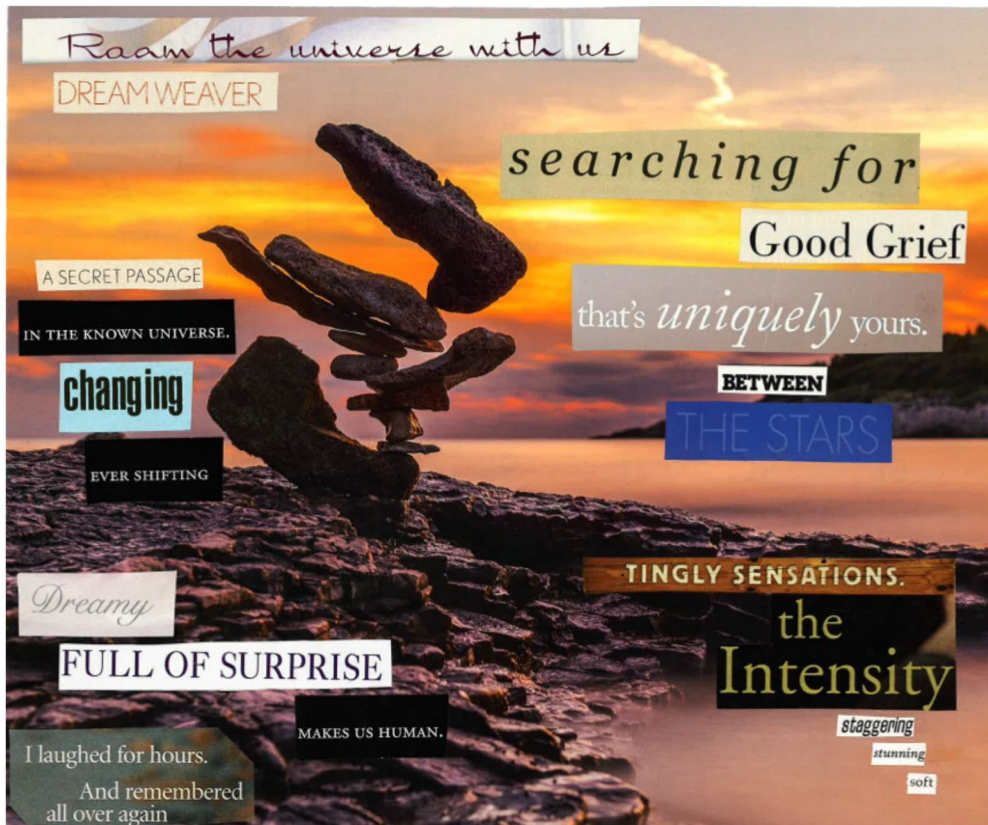


**Figure 1.** *Stay*. By Jenna Hanchey, 2023, mixed media on canvas.
